A high quality, low cost, open pit mine with attractive scale and strong growth potential through near-mine exploration opportunities.

The Mako Gold Mine poured first gold in January 2018. Mako is operated by Resolute's 90%-owned Senegalese subsidiary, Petowal Mining Company SA. The remaining 10% is held by the Government of Senegal which is free-carried.

Located in south-east Senegal, approximately 650km from the capital Dakar, the Mako Gold Mine is a conventional drill and blast, truck and shovel operation with mining services undertaken by an established contractor. The carbon in leach processing plant has 2.3Mtpa of capacity and comprises a crushing circuit, an 8.5MW SAG Mill and gold extraction circuit. The processing plant has achieved strong metallurgical recoveries (95.5% in first year of operation) and is expected to deliver average life of mine recoveries of 93.8%.


